DIRECTIONS FROM I-95: Exit 48 and go STRAIGHT through light onto Larabee Road (.9 miles), turn RIGHT on ME-25/Westbrook Arterial, continue to follow ME-25 (3.9 miles), turn RIGHT onto Mosher Road/ME 237 (2.9 miles), enter the next round about and take the 2nd exit, ME 237 (4.5 miles), Destination 443 Sebago Lake Road is on the RIGHT.

DIRECTIONS FROM THE WEST on 302: Turn RIGHT onto ME 35 in Windham heading South (2.5 miles), turn LEFT onto ME 237 (1 miles), 443 Sebago Lake Road is on the LEFT.

DIRECTION FROM SOUTH ME 35: Cross over Route 114 in Standish, continue approximately 1.5 miles, turn RIGHT onto ME 237 (lake is on the left and Portland Water District is on the right, 443 Sebago Lake Road is on the LEFT
